- There were seven civilian fire casualties, including two severe injuries. However, there were no civilian fire deaths in 2012. There were thirteen fire service casualties, five of which were moderate severity, lost time incidents.
- There were 735 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 381 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2012.
- Approximately 2,750 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 36 educational sessions.
- There were 102 Fire Inspections completed with 186 Violations discovered and 92 corrected.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 356 incidents (including 232 Medical Incidents and 54 Service Calls).
