

Colleton County is an all hazards, full-service, combination department serving 40,000 people in over 1,100 square miles from 35 stations utilizing a staff of 93 full-time, 10 part-time and 125 paid-on-call volunteer firefighters with an annual call volume of more than 9,000. We operate a fleet of 129 vehicles including 36 engines, 34 tenders, 14 ALS ambulances, 2 E-One 95' Platforms, 2 Heavy Rescues, 2 Hazardous Materials Units, and 1 ARFF truck. Colleton County also provides Firefighter/Flight Paramedics to C.A.R.E. Flight, a fully integrated community based air medical program with Med-Trans Corporation that delivers skillful care and rapid transportation to the acutely ill and severely injured throughout South Carolina and in Georgia.
